The Cornell Military Network (CMN) promotes Cornell University's land-grant mission by organizing military-affiliated Cornell alumni across generations in support of the educational, professional, and social advancement of service-minded Cornellians.

CMN's constituency is broad and includes anyone who has served in uniform, performed civilian national defense work, or is interested in military affairs.

Cornell's land grant mission includes a responsibility to teach its students military tactics. Cornell was founded in the wake of the U.S. Civil War, and its students, staff, and faculty have had military experience from the beginning. Cornellians continue to serve in a variety of military roles to this day.

Membership is open to anyone who has attended Cornell for at least a day, taught at Cornell, or worked for Cornell and who supports CMN's purpose and goals.
